Watering Tips

Delay in May. Depending on weather conditions, delay watering in May as long as possible. Doing so will encourage deeper root growth and promote healthier turf and plants that are more drought tolerant and disease resistant in the summer.

Adjust Your Water Application Monthly. Lawns need the most water during the months of July and August; less in May, June and September; and the least in October. Please review the CPN Metropolitan District's **Slow the Flow 2010 Sprinkler System Audit Report** on our homepage at cpnmd.org.

Cycle & Soak. Clay soils typical in Castle Pines absorb water slowly. Conversely, most sprinkler systems apply water rapidly. As a result, sprinklers often apply more water than the soil can immediately absorb, leading to money and water literally flowing down the gutter. Instead of watering for 21 straight minutes per spray zone, please try three short watering cycles of seven-minutes each — with an hour in between each cycle. (Most irrigation control system timers can be set using the "multiple start times" function.)
