CONSIDERATION OF RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF CITY OF CASTLE PINES MILL LEVY QUESTION: Resolution No. 2023-10-01, A Resolution Supporting a "YES" Vote on the City of Castle Pines Ballot Measure 2F was presented to the Board.
